

Extended information on cookies - Cookie policy

This extended information has the specific purpose of illustrating the types and methods of use, as well as explaining what actions to take to refuse or delete cookies on our website.

(Provision of the Guarantor of May 8, 2014 published in G.U. n.126 on 3 June 2014 implementing Directive 2002/58 / EC and EU Regulation 2016/679)

This document is an integral part of the privacy policy and is drawn up in this way only and exclusively to allow the user a better understanding of the use and deactivation of cookies.

It is specified that the user can express his / her own options on the use of cookies present on the site (see detailed list in the part below "cookie types") also through the settings of the browser / s following the instructions provided below. The user can also set the "anonymous surfing" that allows the user to surf the internet without saving any information on the sites, on the pages visited, on any passwords entered and on other parameter information. There are various types of cookies, some make the use of the site more effective, others enable certain features. By browsing our site you are consenting to the use of cookies in accordance with this Cookie Policy. If you do not want to consent to the use of cookies, you must set your browser * appropriately or otherwise you will not be able to use the services rendered by the site. Disabling the cookies used by our site could affect the browsing experience.

Profiling cookies

These cookies are necessary to create user profiles in order to send advertising messages in line with the preferences expressed by the user within the pages of the Site.

This site does not use profiling cookies.

According to current legislation, it is not mandatory to seek consent for cookies and technical analytics, as necessary to provide the required services. For all other types of cookies, consent may be expressed by the User with one or more of the following methods:

What are COOKIES?

Cookies are small text strings that the sites visited by the user send to his terminal (usually the browser), where they are stored before being re-transmitted to the same sites at the next visit of the same user. In addition to cookies are subject to the provision of the Guarantor also other similar instruments (web beacons / web bugs, clear GIFs or atriums) that allow identification of the user or terminal.

During the navigation on a site, the user can also receive cookies on their terminal that are sent from different websites or web servers (so-called "third parties"), on which some elements may exist (such as, for example, images, maps, sounds, specific links to pages of other domains) on the site that the same is visiting.

Cookies, usually present in users' browsers in very large numbers and sometimes even with long temporal persistence, are used for different purposes: execution of computer authentication, monitoring of sessions, storage of information on specific configurations concerning users accessing the server, etc. Further information on cookies can be found at www.allaboutcookies.org.

In order to arrive at a correct regulation of such devices, it is necessary to distinguish them since there are no technical characteristics that differentiate them from one another precisely on the basis of the aims pursued by those who use them. In this direction, however, the same legislator has moved, which, in implementation of the provisions contained in Directive 2009/136 / EC, led back the obligation to obtain the preventive and informed consent of users to the installation of cookies used for purposes other than purely technical ones (see Article 1, paragraph 5, letter a), of Legislative Decree 28 May 2012, n. 69, which amended the art. 122 of the Code).

More Information on the cookies used by this site

Types of cookies

Navigation cookies

These are cookies that guarantee the normal navigation and use of the website and allow the connection between the server and the user's browser. These cookies allow the site to function properly and allow you to view the contents on the device used. Without these cookies some required features such as log-in to the site or the creation of an online shopping cart may not be provided. Navigation cookies are technical cookies and are necessary for the operation of the site.

Functional cookies

These are cookies stored on the computer or other device that, according to the user's request, record the choices of the same, to allow them to remind them of them in order to optimize and provide an improved and personalized navigation within the service or access to this site (eg registration of password in restricted areas, registration of products in the cart to have the opportunity to find them in the next session, save the selected language, view a video or the ability to comment on the blog etc.). Functional cookies are not essential to the operation of the site, but improve the quality and experience of navigation

Analytical cookies

They are cookies that collect information on how the user uses the website, such as which web pages are visited more often. This site uses third-party cookies "Webalizer", a statistical analysis service provided and managed by Webalizer that allows you to analyze, anonymously, how users visit the site. This use of cookies only serves to monitor the performance of our website. We use the following software on our server for this purpose only: <http://www.webalizer.org/>.

You can delete or stop cookies stored on your computer by changing your Internet browser settings. Please note that blocking cookies can reduce the functionality of some websites.

Analytical cookies are not essential for the operation of the site.

Social Network cookies

The most common use is that aimed at sharing the contents of social networks. The presence of plugins involves the transmission of cookies to and from all sites managed by third parties.
